MEMORIAL WALK TO COINCIDE WITH PREGNANCY & INFANT LOSS AWARENESS MONTH

SARATOGA SPRINGS, NY – Angel Names Association (ANA), an area nonprofit association that assists families of stillborn children, will hold its second annual Memorial Walk from 12:00 to 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 13, 2007 at the Saratoga Spa State Park in Saratoga Springs, NY. In 1988, then President Ronald Reagan proclaimed October “National Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness Month.”

Registration will begin at noon at the Columbia Pavilion and the walk will commence at 1:15 p.m. The walk will proceed along paths easily navigable for both strollers and wheelchairs. A nondenominational memorial service remembering babies lost to miscarriage, stillbirth, and infant death will begin at 3:30 p.m. at the Columbia Pavilion field.

The Memorial Walk will provide families an opportunity to acknowledge their baby’s life alongside others who have endured similar tragedies. Participants also have the opportunity to raise money to fund ANA programs that assist bereaved families in New York State and throughout the country. The Memorial Walk’s corporate sponsors include the Adirondack Trust Company, Corinth Merchants Association, GE Bove Fuels, and the Saratoga National Golf Club.
